I would like to inform you about some decisions that we have made in response to the Coronavirus.

The Details:

- We have cancelled our Sunday March 22nd and March 29th services.
 - We will reevaluate our Sunday gatherings following March 29th.
- We have cancelled all other gatherings and events through April 8th.
 - We will reevaluate our other gatherings following April 8th.
- Offerings can be given through the website, or mailed directly to church.

The Pathway & Heart:

- You can rest assured that we are not fearful.
- Our conversations over these difficult decisions has been marked by a calm confidence in God's goodness, control, and sovereign power.
- In making our decisions we have considered the guidance given by governing authorities, ecclesiastical authorities, and the leadership team that God has put in place at Calvary. In this we believe that we are being wisely led by an "abundance of counselors." - Proverb 24:6
- The situation around us is proving to be quite fluid, the available information and suggested responses change daily, and sometimes hourly.
- The path forward that we have chosen is our best attempt at creating a response that is cautious, measured, and gives us a framework that allows for adjustment.
- In the decision making process we have sought to be guided by Scriptures admonition to love one another, and to love our neighbor. We are choosing to show this love, by removing the very possibility for spreading the virus in any one of our canceled gatherings.
